All further cable cars and lifts run daily from 9.00am to 4.00pm.

The ski slopes are closed each day from 5.00pm to 8.45am! You are not permitted to ski or stay on the slopes during these times.

■ Exceptions in Serfaus
The Mittelabfahrt slope, Südbabfahrt slope and the Waldabfahrt slope Serfaus are closed from 6.00pm (except on Wednesdays: The Mittelabfahrt slope and the toboggan run are closed 5.00pm – 6.00pm, open from 6.00pm – 11.00pm for Adventure Night, night skiing & toboggan evening).

■ Exceptions in Fiss
The Ladisabfahrt, Poschiabfahrt and Winklabbahrt slopes are accessible daily from as early as 8.30am, the Möseralm and Winklabbahrt slopes are open for night skiing from 5.45pm to 10.00pm. During the toboggan evening, the tobogganing run is open for tobogganing from 5.45pm to 9.30pm.

On Wednesdays the pistes may be used by "First Track" participants from 7.30am.

Piste maintenance and snow-grooming vehicles with winch cables

We occasionally need to deploy piste maintenance machines on the slopes when they are still being used by skiers. Please ensure you keep a safe distance from such machines in the interests of your own safety. Please heed acoustic and visual warning signals at all times! After pistes close at the end of the day winch cables from piste maintenance devices present a potential hazard. The cable car operators accept no liability for accidents! Please note that in the case of persistent snowfall, groomed slopes may once again become snowed over prior to opening so that they may not always be completely frozen. As a result, moguls and piles of snow may form shortly after the ski slopes are in use.

Closure of pistes and avalanche blasting

For safety reasons, avalanche blasting may take place if large amounts of fresh snow have fallen. Detonations usually take place in the early hours before the start of regular ski operations. If there is a particularly large volume of new snow, avalanche blasting may also have to take place while the slopes are being used by skiers. The affected areas are then closed for skiing! Watch out for information at stations and terminals!

Backcountry skiing

If you intend to go skiing outside the secured area you are advised in the interests of your own safety to find out about the risk of avalanches, any planned avalanche blasting and weather conditions from the cable car operators. Various piste tours from the bottom stations are signposted in the ski resort.

Tobogganing

Please do not use the ski slopes. Use the tobogganing run or the signposted tobogganing slopes.

Skiing accidents

Please report the type and location of the accident to the nearest cable car station or terminal, or contact the mountain rescue services directly.

Inspections and fraudulent use

Admission checks are carried out at the cable car bottom stations using automatic scanners. Please follow the instructions of the staff and use the ticket inspection machines properly. On-the-spot inspections take place in the ski resort. Therefore, you should always carry your ski pass with you. Any incident of fraudulent use or bypassing of the scanners shall result in immediate confiscation of the ski pass. We reserve the right to report the offence to the police. Anyone caught in the inspection zones without a valid ski pass shall be required to pay a fine set at twice the allday ticket rate. A receipt showing that the fine has been paid can be used as a ski pass on the same day. Please note that under the Austrian cable cars liability act, only customers with a valid ski pass are covered for insurance purposes. Do not buy any ski passes from unauthorised vendors – such ski passes may be blocked! Furthermore, you are committing an offence by doing so! Our ski passes are subject to the "photo compare" access control system. This means that at the turnstiles of the feeder cable cars, a photo of the ski pass holder is sometimes taken, which can then be compared with images taken randomly when passing through technically equipped turnstiles in the ski resort. The corresponding pictures are stored in encrypted form and deleted after the ski pass has expired. With the purchase of a ski pass, you give your consent to data processing in the form described. It is also possible to purchase ski passes that are valid on a daily basis and are technically configured so that no photographs are taken when passing through the turnstiles (these ski passes are also randomly checked by our cable car staff).

Limitations on issuance of ski passes

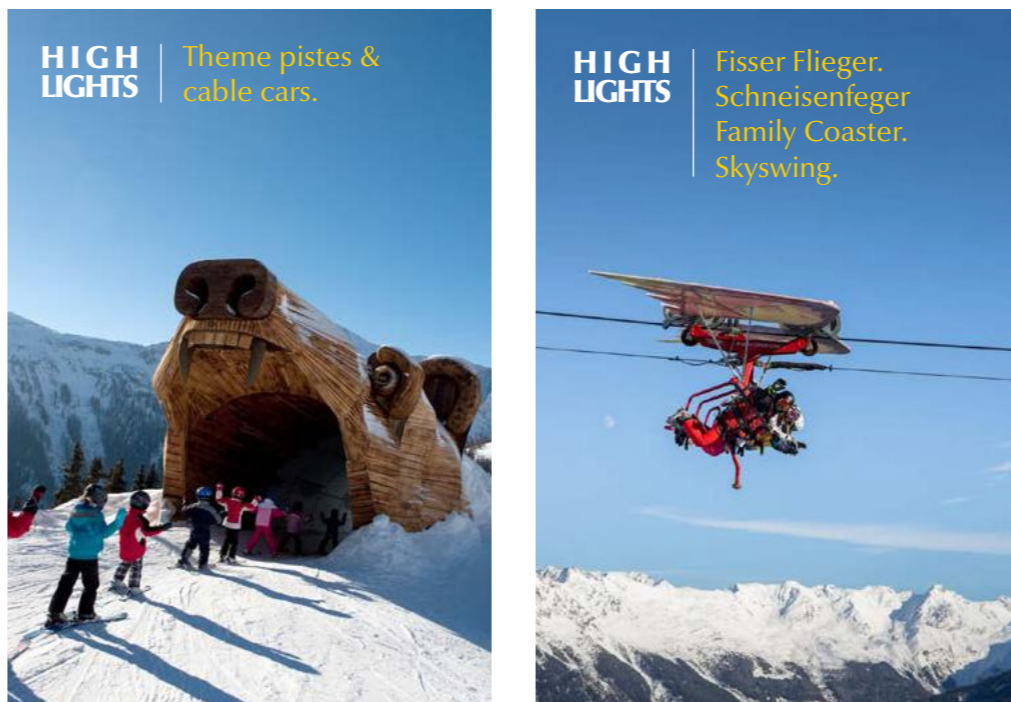

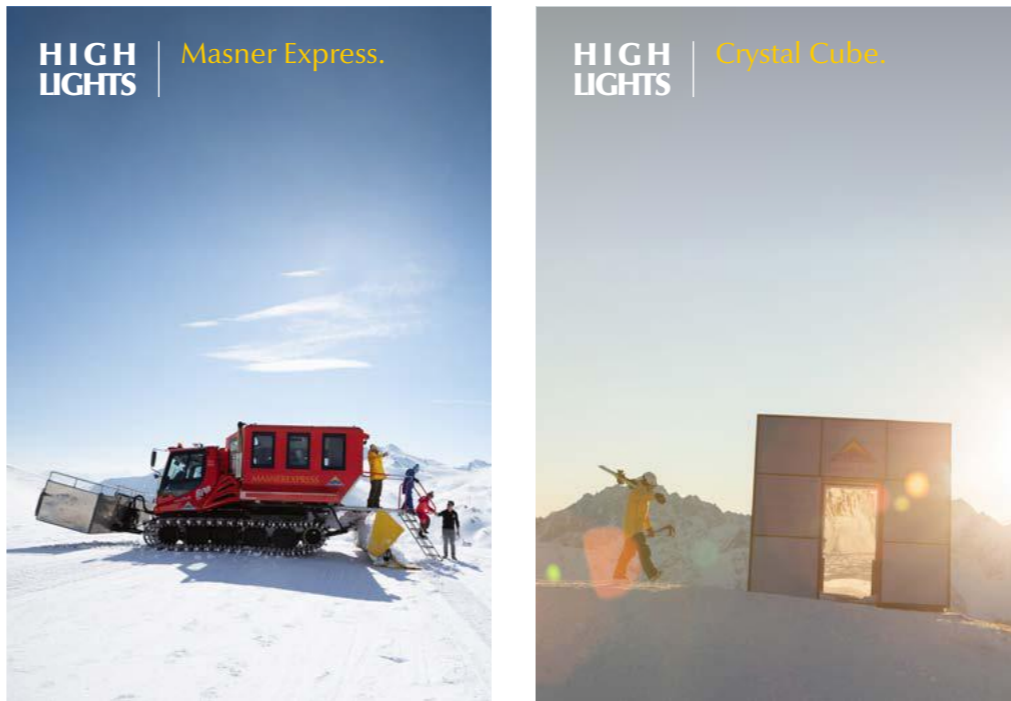

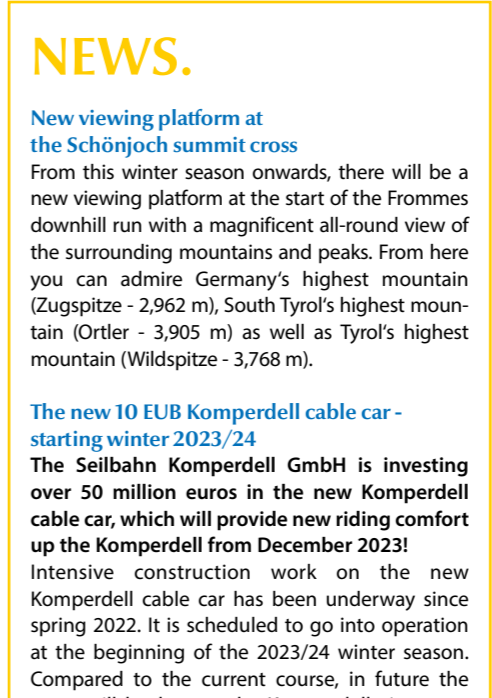

New viewing platform at the Schönjoch summit cross

From this winter season onwards, there will be a new viewing platform at the start of the Frommes downhill run with a magnificent all-round view of the surrounding mountains and peaks. From here you can admire Germany's highest mountain (Zugspitze - 2,962 m), South Tyrol's highest mountain (Ortler - 3,905 m) as well as Tyrol's highest mountain (Wildspitze - 3,768 m).

The new 10 EUB Komperdell cable car - starting winter 2023/24

The Seilbahn Komperdell GmbH is investing over 50 million euros in the new Komperdell cable car, which will provide new riding comfort up the Komperdell from December 2023!

Intensive construction work on the new Komperdell cable car has been underway since spring 2022. It is scheduled to go into operation at the beginning of the 2023/24 winter season. Compared to the current course, in future the route will lead up to the Komperdell via a new mid station in the Mittelabfahrt slope.

The 10-seater cabins will provide a transport capacity of 3,000 people per hour and boast a modern design and a spacious interior. In order to make it easy for children to get on and off, the cable car travels very slowly in the stations; these areas are of course suitable for prams and are barrier-free.

The new bottom station will be built a little further north into the slope - this will make the access area to the Sunliner much more ample and enlarge the forecourt between the Komperdell and Alpkopf cable cars. The ski storage area in the existing bottom station building will be generously extended and equipped with approx. 5,000 parking spaces.

The top station will be integrated into the existing building on the Komperdell, and all levels will be connected via escalators and lifts. The new mid station offers several advantages. On the one hand, the Gampen area will be less congested, as ski school groups can comfortably ski down the Mittelabfahrt slope to the mid station. Secondly, the last, steeper section of the descent can be bypassed with a downhill run from the station to the valley.

Through an additional (winter) hiking trail, the Leithe Wirt restaurant is only a few minutes' walk from the station.
